The activity for week 3 beginning 23rd September is: The African Rhinoceros

The activity we will be covering involves:

Finding out about and identifying some features of the Rhinoceros

Using a variety of materials and tools to create Rhinoceros puzzles

Learning about Africa and the Rhinoceros habitat

Talking about the famous big 5 animals of Africa

Our activity includes:

Look at books with the children and show them big African animals.

A discussion about Rhinoceros, features, types and habitat

Comparing the Rhinos with other big African animals

We will read "I know a Rhino" by Charles Fuge.

We will look at different clips on the internet about the Rhinoceros and the big 5 animals and their habitat.

After each child will be invited to create a Rhino puzzle using paper and glue.

We will use the Rhinoceros for display.

You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.
