



Activities at Home

Dear Parents,

The activity for week 3 beginning is: ‘My new school’

The activity we will be covering involves:

- Learning the names of teachers and children
 - Listening to the story of “Harry and Dinosaurs Go to School” by Ian Whybrow
 - Talking about favourite activities at school.
 - Participating in an art activity.
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Our activity includes:

- At first the children will be invited to sit in a circle and they will be encouraged to introduce themselves.
- We will read the story of “Harry and Dinosaurs Go to School” by Ian Whybrow. We will talk about the story and focus on a new boy Jack who has just started new school.
- Then we will talk about our school. We will talk about what to expect at Nursery and in which activities the children will have opportunity to participate. The children will be encouraged to find their pegs and drawers. We will be discussing children’s favourite toys, books and games.
- The children will take part in art activity and they will decorate ‘Starting School’ certificate.

You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.

Our suggested activities are:

- read books with your child about starting school e.g. ‘Maisy goes to preschool’, ‘Topsy and Tim start school’
- talk about your school with your child e.g. about your uniform, best friends, favourite activities or school trips
- if possible, try to arrange play dates with other children, maybe in the park or try to walk/ scoot to school together
