is:

My Thoughts & Feelings/Marvellous Meabout Coronavirus

The activity we will be covering involves:

- To discuss thoughts & feelings around coronavirus
- To explore words and meanings of those words around coronavirus
- To express imagination & creativity
- To explore music beats to learn the Coronavirus rap!
- To have fun!

All about the activity:

First children will be invited to discuss what they think the Coronavirus is. They will have the opportunity to share their views of what words like 'pandemic' & 'quarantine' are and what that means in child appropriate language.

Next children will look at PowerPoint slides with information about Coronavirus.

Following that, children will use their imaginations and creativity to create a coronavirus character. They will be able to create a digital character using ICT, and a hand drawn character using a variety of art materials.

Children's artwork, views and comments will be used as part of a classroom display.

Lastly children will have the opportunity to learn the Coronavirus Rap!
