The activity for week 3 beginning: 18th January is: The Three Little Pigs

The activity we will be covering involves:

- **Develop listening and attention skills**
 - **Developing problem-solving skills**
 - **Developing self-confidence and self-awareness**
 - **Developing observational skills**
 - **Using their imagination and creativity**
 - **Developing fine and gross motor skills**
 - **Learning new vocabulary**
 - **Working together, taking turns, and sharing**
 - **Selecting the resources and tools they need to make and create**
 - **Developing an understanding of rhyme and alliteration**
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Our activity includes:

- **Reading the story of The Three Little Pigs using small world props and resources.**
- **Table 1: A tough spot tray will be set up with resources and small-world toys for the children to have the opportunity to act out the story using Lego, sticks, shredded paper and small-world pigs and a puppet wolf.**
- **Table 2: Making homes for The Three Little Pigs**
The children will use various resources to make homes for the pigs for a display board.
- **Learning the Three Little Pigs rhyme.**
- **Making a story map of the traditional story**



You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.

Our suggested activities are:

- **Encouraging your child to choose favourite stories and rhymes.**
- **Making their own representations of the Three Little Pigs homes in the garden or inside.**
