‘Once Upon a Time’

Dear Parents,

The activity for week 11 week commencing 15th March is: **‘The Frog Prince’**

The activity we will be covering involves:

- Understanding what fairy tales are and make predictions showing understanding of ideas, events and characters
 - Learn new vocabulary and communicate their ideas and thoughts
 - Encouraging critical thinking
 - Developing fine motor skills
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Our activity includes:

- Read “The Frog Prince” to the children
 - Start a conversation about their favourite fairy tales and why they like it
 - Promote turn taking when playing ““Turn the frog into a prince” game
 - Encourage the children to create their own crown
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You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.

Our suggested activities are:

- Visit the Wetland Centre or just take a walk by the lake in the King George’s park in Wandsworth to see some frogs
- Watch tadpoles grow
- Read other fairy tales books such as:
 “The Princess and the pea” **“Rumpelstiltskin”**
 “Jack and the Beanstalk” **“ The Three Billy Goats Gruff”**

- Read some books about
 - “From tadpole to Frog” by Shannon Zemlicka,
 - “Franklin the Frog” by Barry Tranter and Emma Tranter
 - “Is that a frog?” by Claire Llewellyn
 - “I don’t want to be a frog” by Dev Petty
