The activity for week 4 beginning 25th January is: No room for baby Roo

The activity we will be covering involves:

- Identifying and learning about different animals from the story
- To identify Australia on the world map.
- Moving and skipping like Kangaroos
- Learning and singing a new song
- Working with creative media to make a Kangaroo.

## Our activity includes:

• Read the book "No room for a baby Roo by Neil Griffiths <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=zQhCqWOeTMU</u> - this is a wonderful reading session!

- Discussion about the content of the book and let the children skip around the garden like Kangaroos
- Look at the different animals that live in Australia and ask the children if they have seen these animals?
- Learn about Australia and look for it in the map
- Children will have the opportunity to make a Kangaroo with creative media.

Home learners can you make a K for kangaroo and try writing K.

- Look at books about Australia
