The activity for week: 8

beginning: 30th October

Is: 'All about Marvellous Me'

The activity we will be covering involves:

- Using language to describe and talk about yourself in front of your teachers and peers
 - Developing new language and new vocabulary
 - Developing fine and gross motor skills
 - Talking about past and future events
 - Taking turns and sharing.
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Our activity includes:

- Begin with the book, 'What will you be by Yamile Saied Mendez This book celebrates your own uniqueness and encourage a child to be whatever they want not matter what.
- Invite the children to take turns to describe a bit about themselves, for example; "I am funny/big/tall"

- The children will ask to provide a shoe box to decorate at Nursery and to bring their favourite toy, book, photos. The children will have the opportunity to talk and describe what is inside their own box and tell us why these items are important to them
