The activity for week: 7 beginning: 19th February 2024

is: 'Wild Cats'

The activity we will be covering involves:

- Learning about the different cats and their habitat.
- Discussing important facts about different kinds of cats
- Looking at various books about the big cats
- Teaching and talking about endangered species.

Our activity includes:

Looking at factual books about different cats and their habitat to develop a clearer knowledge of the different species. The following books will be used for references:

Big Cat by Rhonda Klevasky.

Animal Watch a visual introduction to Big Cats by Bernard Stonehouse.

Scary Creatures' big cats by Penny Clarke and Terry Riley.

Our activity will involve creating a jungle collage using paint, sand and a template of a tiger. Children will be encouraged to cut their own tiger template. We will display the collages.

You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.

Our suggested activities are:

- Look and read different books about wild cats such as: The Tiger who came to Tea, Baby lion, Lions at lunch time, Jungle book.
- Take a trip to the London Zoo.
- Watch the Lion king or the jungle book movie with your child.
