## Project: "Splish, Splash, splosh"

#### Dear Parents,

The activity for week: 2

beginning: 22<sup>nd</sup> April is: <u>'Rainbow Fish'</u>

### The activity we will be covering involves:

- Talking about fish and where they live, making predictions and showing understanding of ideas and characters in the story
- Learn new vocabulary e.g. scales and communicate their ideas and thoughts
- Encouraging critical thinking
- Developing fine motor skills

# Our activity includes:

- Read "Rainbow Fish" by Marcus Pfister to the children
- Start a conversation about fish and where they live and what they may eat
- Discuss with the children about sharing and the happiness that sharing can
- Encourage the children to participate in a craft activity making a Rainbow fish

You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations. Our suggested activities are:

- Read other stories in the Rainbow fish series such as "The Rainbow fish discovers the Deep Sea" or "Good Night, Little Rainbow Fish" by Marcus Pfister
- Visit the library and read some non-fiction books about fish
- Visit the Sea life, any London zoo, or a pet store to see fish in action. Some garden centres have aquariums.
