



### Activities at Home

#### **Project: “Splish, Splash, splosh”**

**Dear Parents,**

The activity for week: 2 beginning: 22<sup>nd</sup> April is: **‘Rainbow Fish’**

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#### **The activity we will be covering involves:**

- Talking about fish and where they live, making predictions and showing understanding of ideas and characters in the story
  - Learn new vocabulary e.g. scales and communicate their ideas and thoughts
  - Encouraging critical thinking
  - Developing fine motor skills
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#### **Our activity includes:**

- Read “Rainbow Fish” by Marcus Pfister to the children
  - Start a conversation about fish and where they live and what they may eat
  - Discuss with the children about sharing and the happiness that sharing can
  - Encourage the children to participate in a craft activity making a Rainbow fish
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**You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.**

#### **Our suggested activities are:**

- Read other stories in the Rainbow fish series such as **“The Rainbow fish discovers the Deep Sea”** or **“Good Night, Little Rainbow Fish”** by Marcus Pfister
- Visit the library and read some non-fiction books about fish
- Visit the Sea life, any London zoo, or a pet store to see fish in action. Some garden centres have aquariums.
