Project: ‘Splish, splash, splosh...’

Dear Parents,

The activity for week: 6 beginning: 20th May is: ‘Puddles’

The activity we will be covering involves:

- Listening to a new story “Found You. Little Wombat”
- Introducing the concept of the water cycle
- Encouraging the children to join in while learning a new song
- Developing gross motor skills while jumping in puddles in the garden

Our activity includes:

- At first the children will listen to a story “Found You, Little Wombat!” by Angela McAllister
- Then we will talk about rain and what we should wear and what we need when it is raining
- We will introduce the concept of water cycle through a song
- The children will be learning a new song “Splashing in the puddles”
- We will place some ‘puddles’ in the classroom and the children will be encouraged to jump from one puddle to another
- The children will be asked to wear wellington boots and they will be jumping in the puddles in the forest.

You might wish to help your child to explore this topic at home or when you are out and about. Please feel free to approach the teachers for further explanations.

Our suggested activities are:

- Make a storm using musical instruments
- On a dry day, use large paintbrushes and paint the floors and walls outside with water.
- Make puddles with a hose!
